**PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENT MUST HALT SALE AND/OR LEASE OF FOUR PROPERTIES
SHOWCASED AT INVESTORS' CONFERENCE**

Dear Minister Grant,

1. On 17 April 2014, the Social Justice Coalition, Equal Education, and Ndifuna Ukwazi made a joint submission to the Provincial Ministry of Transport and Public Works regarding the sale and/or lease of four properties showcased at an investors' conference held in Cape Town on 26 March 2014. This submission – which called for an immediate halt to this process – is attached for your reference.
2. On the day of the submission, I received a telephone call from MEC for Transport and Public Works, Minister Robin Carlisle. Details of that telephone call are attached for your reference.
3. We demand an undertaking that you will halt any sale/lease of the land referred to in the submission, in order to consult immediately on using available land, including Province-owned land, for a broader plan to deal adequately with the urgent spatial planning and housing needs

of the city, particularly for those most vulnerable and in need. We request that you provide a response to our submission demand in writing by no later than Wednesday 18 June 2014.
